

## Removing applications on Windows Mobile devices

You can remove an application from your Windows Mobile device using ActiveSync on your PC or, if a computer is not available, directly from the device.

### *Removing an application using ActiveSync*

1. Connect your mobile device to the computer.
2. On the computer, in the notification area, double-click the **ActiveSync** icon.
3. On the **Tools** menu, click **Add/Remove Programs**.
4. In the list of installed and available programs, clear the check boxes for the programs that you wish to uninstall.
5. To confirm the removal of these programs, click **Remove**.

If you do not have a copy of ActiveSync it is a free download available from our Software Library and the Microsoft website.

### *Removing an application directly from a Windows Mobile device*

1. On the Today screen, tap **Start**, and then tap **Settings**.
2. On the Settings screen, on the **System** tab, tap **Remove Programs**.
3. To remove an application, on the **Remove Programs** page, in the list of installed programs, tap the program that you wish to remove, and then tap **Remove**.
4. In the warning message that appears asking if you really want to remove the program, tap **Yes**.

**Note:** When uninstalling applications using either method, you may need to perform a soft reset of your Windows Mobile device.
